MINUTES: Board of Directors Meeting, April 11, 2016

1. **Called to order:** 4:15 pm, Elizabeth Brownrigg's house, North Road, Carson. President Elizabeth Brownrigg presided.

4. **Accepted minutes?**
5. **Phone Tree.** The Board reviewed the revised phone tree document, how it should work and when it should be used. The President would call the Section Leaders in turn who would then each call the groups of people in their sections. One of the Section Leaders might call the President to initiate the calling. The Fire Department would also have a copy of the phone tree.

The phone tree would be used in the event of an emergency and also to promote upcoming community events.

6. **The Dog Issue.**
There have been a number of complaints about dogs in our community, including aggressive dogs approaching people, free roaming dogs on other peoples' property, and persistently barking dogs. The board decided that it would write a letter to members of the community. The headline to the letter would be something like "If you own a dog this letter is for your attention". The letter will be drafted and reviewed by members of the board, and distributed with a summary of the most relevant parts of the 2015 Taos County Animal Control Ordinance, and relevant parts of New Mexico State Law. The goal of the letter will be to put dog owners on notice that if they continue to contravene State and County statutes that they will reported to the County Animal Control Office.
7. **Date of next meeting.** The Board will arrange to meet about two weeks after the Spring Bling Fling (May 14 2016) to assess its success. Coordination of the Spring Bling Fling will be done via email.
8. **Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 5.15 pm.
